IDENTIFY YOUR STUFF!

Camp Oakhurst cannot be responsible for lost or stolen belongings. It is important that you mark your name on every personal item (especially Bibles). Use a waterproof pen, a sewn-on nametag or embroidery to mark all items. Unclaimed lost and found items are held for one week after your group departs.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Knives/guns, Matches, Lighters, Alcohol, Tobacco/cigarettes,
Unsuitable novels, Fireworks, Drugs, Food.

TIME TO EAT!

Meals are very important at Camp Oakhurst. We want you to have a delicious and joy-filled experience. We serve all meals buffet style, and are happy to consider any of your requests.

General Information

- Standard meal times are:
 - ⇒ **8:00** Breakfast
 - ⇒ **12:30** Lunch
 - ⇒ **5:30** Dinner (A later time on the night of arrival may be arranged.)
- Please notify kitchen staff if you anticipate a delay for a mealtime.
- Do not take dishes, glasses and silverware out of the dining area.
- Our staff needs about 30 minutes to clean up the serving areas before your next scheduled meeting time in the Dining Hall.
- Snacks are available at an additional charge and must be selected two weeks prior to arrival. A list of options is available.



Special Diets: Food allergies are a special concern for our staff. If anyone in your group has a special need, please let us know at least two weeks prior to your arrival. We must place our food order in advance of your arrival, and appreciate your cooperation as we strive to accommodate as many requests as possible.

All Groups

- ✓ Campers / guests assist with setting tables (if pre-setting is desired).
- ✓ During meals, assistance with **keeping food waste to a minimum** is greatly appreciated! Returning to the buffet line for seconds is always an option.
- ✓ Assistance is also requested following meals:
 - Clearing plates, cups, silverware
 - Wiping down tables
- ✓ One adult counselor should sit at each table and should remain with the group until clean up is complete.



After each meal, coordinate KP group to clear and wipe down tables, stack chairs, and pick up trash from the floor. (Napkin holders and salt and pepper shakers may remain on the tables.)

**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED
AT ANY TIME:**

1. Immodest or inappropriate dress
2. Illegal drugs or alcohol
3. Food in your room, cabin, buildings or the pool
4. Pets
5. Fireworks
6. Firearms
7. Visitors must check in at the office
8. Motorcycles or ATV's are not to be brought on the grounds, unless they have been pre-approved.

**We retain the right to remove any guest from the grounds
for:**

1. Use/consumption of alcohol or drugs
2. Possession of firearms, other weapons or threats of bodily harm to other guests, campers or staff
3. Discharge of fireworks and/or construction of fires outside of authorized fire sites
4. Acts of vandalism
5. Inappropriate sexual actions
6. Refusal to follow instructions of policies of Camp Oakhurst leaders
